

PCYA Leadership Academy

The **Leadership Academy** is a collaborative venture by the Pennsylvania Children and Youth Administrators and the Child Welfare Training program. It addresses the needs of administrators by offering high quality management and leadership training. As the complexity of county child welfare has increased, it has become more important that the practitioners have high level skills and expertise. The Leadership Academy provides opportunities for Administrators and their management staff to stay current with changing laws, theory and practice, enhancing their knowledge and skills. Continuing Education Credits are available for participants.

The Foundation Course is a 12-hour (two day) training that focuses on leadership skill building for individuals or management teams. Additional Leadership Academy training consists of five topical Tracks, providing an array of learning opportunities. These Tracks are:

Leadership

Organizational Development

Systems Integration

Fiscal

Human Resources

These three-hour course offerings are available throughout the year at various venues, including PCYA quarterly meetings. Certificates and a pin will be awarded upon completion of 27 training hours, inclusive of the Foundation Course.
